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Although irregularities of the skin are possible following liposuction, the side effects are greatly minimized when using the Tumescent Techniques. There is minimal pain and the vast majority receives only minor sedation to relax during surgery. Following the procedure, most patients can return to work or daily activity in 3-4 days.

Who is it for?

Those individuals best suited for liposuction contouring are active healthy persons of average or near average weight. Facial liposuction is a good choice for those who just cannot lose that unwanted fat and who seek improvement on the shape of their face and neck.

You may be a good candidate for Facial Liposuction if:

- You have excess weight in your chin and neck region.
- You have areas of stubborn fat that just won't respond to diet and exercise..

Facial liposuction can also be combined with a facelift, brow lift, eyelid lift or other cosmetic procedures for an even more dramatic result.

Facial Liposuction

Diet and exercise can help many areas of the body, but nothing seems to affect those fatty deposits in your cheeks, chin, jaw line or neck. These areas just don't respond well

to diet and exercise. They can also obscure who you really are. Now, facial liposuction can provide you with a solution.

Today liposuction is one of the most common cosmetic procedures performed. When performed by your skin care expert under the modern tumescent technique, it is the safest form of fat removal available.

How It Works

While each surgeon may approach the surgery differently, a facial liposuction is designed to improve the appearance of the lower face, cheeks, neck and chin area.

Facial Liposuction is typically performed right in our office using local tumescent anesthesia. A saline solution containing dilute anesthetic and adrenaline is injected into the fatty tissue through the small incision site. The injected area then becomes locally anesthetized rather than generally as was the traditional method. This solution allows the surgeon to extract the fat in a more accurate and uniform fashion thereby producing smoother results.

A small stainless steel tube called a cannula is then inserted through tiny incisions in the skin and the fat is removed utilizing suction.

The incisions are so small they heal themselves with only the use of a few sutures and minimal scarring if any. When the procedure is finished the patient may be required to wear facial bandages for support under the chin. Make sure to follow any post-surgical instructions your surgeon and/or his staff gives you.

Where else is Liposuction used?

Fat that deposits on the flanks, hip, abdomen, inner and outer thighs, knees and legs are areas where body contouring with liposuction produces impressive results. The most frequently treated areas in women are the abdomen, hips, thighs and knees while men are the "love handles" and enlarged male-breasts.

What you should Know?

Facial liposuction is the skillful re-contouring of face and neck by removing excess fatty deposits. This procedure can be used to help restore that youthful appearance.

Remember, when fat cells are removed by liposuction, they tend not to grow back. The patient's new balanced silhouette is permanent. However, if the patient does gain weight, the change tends to be distributed proportionately over the entire body.

As with any surgical procedure, liposuction is associated with possible side effects such as bruising, swelling, temporary numbness and discomfort in the surgical area treated.
