What is IPL?

IPL utilizes Intense Pulsed Light (IPL) technology for the treatment of skin conditions caused by skin aging and sun exposure.

How does it work?

IPL works by delivering gentle pulses of light energy to a targeted region. Below the surface of the skin, the light energy will promote collagen growth and help fill in small lines and wrinkles. At the surface of the skin, the light energy will stimulate the generation of new healthy cells. This will help restore your skin to its natural beauty, blending its natural colors and making it smoother, vibrant and younger looking.

What areas can be treated?

Virtually any area of your body can be treated. The most common areas are those most exposed to the damaging effects of the sun, including the face, neck, back of the

hands, chest and shoulders. Photo rejuvenation can be used to restore lost skin tone, remove blemishes, age spots, and unwanted facial veins vessels. It treats rosacea, acne, and even sun damage. The treatment process.

A topical anesthetic may be applied to the surface of the skin to minimize discomfort during treatment. Following the short 15 to 45 minute laser session, the treated area will be cleaned and your laser specialist will give you important instructions including the use

You will be able to return to work or regular activities immediately following treatment. You might experience some redness at the treatment site, but that should resolve within a few hours. Use a good sunscreen whenever it is impossible to avoid exposure to the sun during the healing process.
